General Information

- A dog is considered to be "at large" if it is off the premises of the owner and not under the control of the owner by leash, cord, chain or otherwise.
- Dogs are not allowed in City Parks or Cemeteries even if they are on a leash
- Millville City requires proof of a current rabies vaccination signed by a licensed veterinarian or documentation from a certified veterinarian stating that there is a medical reason that prevents the vaccination from being administered.
- Any Change to the information on the license must be provided to Milliville City so that records can be updated. The owner must provide in writing any of the following changes: dog ownership, residing address, loss or return of a dog, death of a dog.
- Dog tags are not transferable from one dog to another. In the case that a dog tag is lost or destroyed, a duplicate will be issued upon presentation of a receipt showing the payment of the license fee for the current year and a tag fee payment of \$1.00.
- No refunds will be made on any fees because of death/loss of a dog or the owner leaving the City before expiration of the license period.

Animal Control Services

• Impounded dogs may **only** be released by the designated Millville City Employee after a current license and full fee payment are received. Full payment will include impound fees and a possible fine. After five violations, the owner of the dog may be required by the court to remove the dog from the premises.
